TERMS & CONDITIONS

PAYMENT, CANCELLATION & REFUND POLICY:

A non-refundable deposit of \$500 is required to hold a reservation. Balance of payment is due 50 days prior to departure. If cancellation in writing is received more than 45 days prior to departure, a full refund less the deposit will apply. If cancellation in writing is received within 45 days of departure the deposit plus any amount the ground operator, airline & hotel withhold are non-refundable.

FORM OF PAYMENT:The cost of the tour is based on payment by personal check. Credit cards are accepted with a 3.5% surcharge and a written authorization to St. Olav Travel by e-mail or letter.

ITINERARIES: Itineraries are prepared in advance and are subject to change. Activities are planned and scheduled according to the best information available at the time.

BAGGAGE: Each tour participant is permitted 1 suitcase (max. of 50 pounds) and 1 carry-on plus a personal item due to the airline restrictions.

DOCUMENTATION: All passengers must have a passport that is valid at least three months from the return date. U.S. citizens do not need visas or vaccinations: However, visa and health requirements are subject to change. For citizens of other countries check with the consulate of Lithuania.

ROOM OCCUPANCY: Tour costs are based on double occupancy. Accommodation in a single room is available at an additional cost.

TRAVELERS INSURANCE: Travel Insurance is highly recommended. We do not accept any responsibility for loss or damage to property as a result of handling and/or accidents.

MEALS: As the meals offered during the tour are pre-arranged, we normally are not able to accommodate special dietary needs or restrictions.

Lithuania's jeweled Baroque capital, the mystical Hill of Crosses, the city founded by St. Maximilian Kolbe, Eastern Europe's venerable Marian Shrine of Czestochowa, Poland's former royal capital, mountain resort beloved by St. John Paul II, Shrine of the Infant of Prague in Czech Republic's ancient capital and the sites connected to St. Maria Faustina and Divine Mercy! Travel with a chaplain from the Discalced Friars of the California-Arizona province.

Day 1 - Late afternoon flight departure from LAX to Warsaw and on to Vilnius.

Day 2 - Late afternoon arrival in Vilnius. Transfer to our downtown hotel, the Domus Maria, for check-in, dinner and overnight (3 nights).

Day 3 - A day excursion to two of Lithuania's most important places of pilgrimage; the Marian Sanctuary of Siulva where the Blessed Virgin Mary visited local villagers over four-hundred years ago and the fascinating Hill of Crosses (near Siauliai)! Despite the crosses being thrice destroyed by authorities, they miraculously reappeared each time and can be witnessed today. Enjoy the shrines and beautiful countryside before returning to Vilnius for dinner and overnight.

Day 4 – FEAST DAY OF DIVINE MERCY! Morning at the Sanctuary of the Divine Mercy where the young Polish nun, Sr. Faustina Maria Kowalska first received from Our Holy Saviour Himself instructions to have the image of Divine Mercy painted. See the original image! Afternoon visit to Ostra Brama, “Gate of Dawn”, home of a miraculous 16th Century Icon. Enjoy an afternoon tour of gorgeous Old Town. Dinner and overnight in Vilnius.

Day 5 - Today we bid farewell to Lithuania and travel southwest to Bialystok, situated in a pretty forest known as the “Green Lungs of Poland”. Stop en-route in Sokolka to visit St. Anthony of Padua Church, site of a Eucharistic Miracle in 2008! Afternoon arrival at the Divine Mercy Sanctuary in Bialystok wherein are the remains of Fr. Michael Sopocko, confessor of St. Faustina, who was beatified here in 2008. Early evening arrival, check-in, dinner and overnight at Best Western Hotel Cristal in Bialystok.

Day 6 - Morning departure for Lichen Stary with a stop in Niepokalanow, the fabulous town founded by St. Maximilian Kolbe, “Martyr of Charity”! Evening arrival, check-in and overnight at Hotel Atut in Lichen Stary.

Day 7 - Morning in Lichen Stary to visit Poland's very beautiful and new basilica (2004), housing an icon of the Virgin Mary under the title of Our Lady of Sorrows. This basilica has a history dating to 1813 when a Polish soldier fighting under Napoleon was seriously wounded. Upon the soldier's pleading to Our Lady for her intercession, she appeared to him and asked that her image be cast and displayed, saying, “My people will pray before this image and shall draw many graces at my hands in the hardest times of trial.” Our next stop is in Glogowiec where St. Faustina was born. Our final destination today is Czestochowa, Eastern Europe's most venerable shrine; home of the 15th Century Jasna Gora Monastery and Black Madonna Icon. Mid-afternoon arrival, visit to the shrine, Check-in, Dinner and overnight at Hotel Mercure Centrum.

Day 8 - Morning departure south for royal Krakow; Poland's first capital. Afternoon arrival and city tour of beautiful Old Town taking in historic Wawel Castle and Cathedral and St. Mary's Church. Also visit Cloth Hall (world's oldest Mall). Check-in, Dinner and overnight at Hotel Vienna House (3 nights).

Day 9 - A wonderful day excursion to Wadowice and Lagiewniki; sites of Pope John Paul II and Divine Mercy! Our first stop will be in Wadowice where the future pope was born on May 18, 1920. Next is the Shrine of Divine Mercy in Lagiewniki on the site of the convent of the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy, the order to whom St. Faustina

belonged. Visit the basilica consecrated by St. John Paul II (2002) and the chapel housing the precious image of Divine Mercy. Late afternoon return, Dinner and overnight in Krakow.

Day 10 - A day excursion to the mountain resort of Zakopane, a favorite of St. of our Lady of Fatima (subject to confirmation), colorful Krupowki Street and more. Dinner and overnight in Krakow.

Day 11 - Morning departure southwest for Czech Republic, heading to Prague, the “City of 100 Spires”. Prague was spared from destruction during World War II and much of its historical architecture remains. Late afternoon arrival in Prague for Check-in, Dinner and overnight at Hotel Occidental Praha.

Day 12 - A day in the exquisite city of Prague beginning with a city tour to include Loreto Church, St. George Basilica and St. Vitus Cathedral (used for the inauguration of Presidents). Next is the Prague Castle and Golden Lane, a row of tiny artisans' shops built outside the castle walls in medieval times. Cross Charles Bridge to Old Town. See the Astronomical Clock which comes alive when the hour strikes and the twelve disciples appear to bless the crowd. Finally, visit the Church of Our Lady Victorious to see the renowned statue of the Infant Jesus of Prague and learn of its storied past with roots dating back to St. Teresa of Avila in 1555. In 1635, amongst the ruins of a war-torn city, a Carmelite friar, Fr. Cyril, found this statue and placed it in the monastery chapel when he heard, “THE MORE YOU HONOR ME, THE MORE I WILL BLESS YOU.” Farewell Dinner.

Day 13 -Today we fly home from Prague to Los Angeles via Warsaw. Late afternoon arrival in Los Angeles.
